EXHIBIT A

A PORTION OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, FERNANDINA BEACH, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Said portion being more particularly described as follows: For a point of reference commence at the Northeast corner of Section 6 aforementioned; and run North 88°-23' West along the Northerly line of said Section, a distance of 593.11 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
