WHEREAS, ARTHUR I. JACOBS has served the County of Nassau in an exemplary fashion in his duties with the Board of County Commissioners, and


WHEREAS, ARTHUR I. JACOBS has exhibited extraordinary leadership qualities and given outstanding service to the citizens of the County of Nassau, and


WHEREAS, he has worked tirelessly for the Board of County Commissioners in all aspects of the County's legal affairs;




