RESOLUTION OF COMMITMENT TOWARDS THE PURCHASE OF TWO ADDITIONAL SHERIFF'S PATROL CARS BASED UPON THE KINGS BAY IMPACE COORDINATING COMMITTEES NOTIFICATION OF FEDERAL FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the development of the King's Bay Submarine Base has precipitated unprecedented growth pressures of the County of Nassau, and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need for additional Sheriff's patrol vehicles in light of this unprecedented growth, and

WHEREAS, the county lacks the resources necessary to acquire additional patrol vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the King's Bay Impact Coordinating Committee has notified the county that they anticipate federal funding in the amount of \$24,000.00 for two patrol cars,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED contingent upon the receipt of the \$24,000.00 in federal funding, the county will:

- 1.) Prepare any necessary bid documents for the cars
- 2.) Utilize the funds for the purchase of the two patrol cars
- 3.) Take whatever other actions are necessary to successfully obtain these patrol cars
