

RESOLUTION 86-48

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION
BEFORE THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE RELATING TO THE
HOMESTEAD TAX EXEMPTION LAW.

WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution 246, House Bill PCB 86-11:1
and Senate Bill 54, relating to the Homestead Tax Exemption Law,
have been introduced to the Florida Legislature during the 1986
Legislative Session; and

WHEREAS, 38% of the tax-payers of Nassau County are paying
taxes as a result of the existing Homestead Tax Exemption Law;
and

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Nassau County, Florida,
deems it necessary that an amendment be made to the existing
Homestead Tax Exemption Law; and

WHEREAS, the above referenced bills would be fair and
equitable solutions to the existing Homestead Tax Exemption Law
and would be in the best interests of the citizens of the State
of Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PEOPLE OF NASSAU
COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Commission of Nassau County does
hereby support action to reform the Homestead Tax Exemption Law
and does further urge the Florida Legislature to pass one of the
above-referenced Bills.
