school crossing program, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has an on going school crossing

program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. Prior to the division of traffic fine monies for the

County and the City, four (\$4.00) dollars from each traffic fine

collected shall be tendered to the Sheriff's department for the

School Crossing Program.

2. The monies to be disbursed by the Clerk pursuant to

procedures set forth by his office.
