RESOLUTION 87-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA OF INTENT TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL FOUR (4) CENTS PER GALLON GAS TAX, PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES, CHAPTER 336.025: DISTRIBUTION OF SAID GAS TAX MONIES SHALL BE AMONG THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT AND ELIGIBLE MUNICIPALITIES BASED UPON THE TRANSPORTATION EXPENDITURES FOR EACH OF THE FIVE (5) FISCAL YEARS PRECEDING THE YEAR IN WHICH THE TAX WAS AUTHORIZED.

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau, due to homestead exemptions, has lost approximately 52% of the real property proceeds of the County off the tax rolls, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau cannot construct and or maintain sufficient road systems for the citizens of Nassau County without a gas tax, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau has, in effect, a two (2) cents local option gas tax, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received petitions, letters, and heard from the citizenship as to the need for an additional gas tax to address the road problem in the County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida intends to enact an additional four (4) cents per gallon gas tax and the distribution of said gas tax shall be as provided above. Further, the County has directed that an Ordinance be drafted and said Ordinance be advertised for public hearing as required by law.
