A RESOLUTION SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING OF THOSE CERTAIN RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR ALLEYS IN THE HEREIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY, AND THE RENOUNCING AND DISCLAIMING OF ANY RIGHT OR INTEREST OF SAID NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND THE PUBLIC IN SAID RIGHTS OF WAY OR ALLEYS.

Rufus Williams WHEREAS, has petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, to close, vacate and abandon and to renounce an disclaim the right and interest of * Nassau County, Florida, and the public in and to those certain rights-of-way or alleys described as follows: That portion of South

Third Street right-of-way that lies Between the Northerly right-of-way line of Olive Street and the Southerly right-of-way line of Nectarine Street, that portion of Olive Streetright-of-way that lies between the Easterly right-of-way line of South Thrid Street right-of-way and the Westerly right-of-way of South Fourth Street and that portion of South Fourth Street right-of-way that lies between the Northerly right-of-way line of Pine Street and the Southerly right-of-way line of Nectarine Street, Fernandina, Nassau County, Florida. According to the official plat of said City (as lithographed and issued by the Florida Railroad Company in 1857 and enlarged, revised and re-issued by the Florida Town Improvement Company in 1887 and 1901).

WHEREAS, Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, authorizes this Board to close, vacate and abandon streets, roads and alleys and to renounce and disclaim the right and interest of Nassau County, Florida, an of the public in and to lands delineated on any recorded map or plat as a street, alley, road or highway outside of the corporate limits of any municipality after given notice of and holding a public hearing to determine whether such action should be taken.

Florida, on the 17th day of March A.D. 1987, at <u>9:00</u> o'clock <u>p</u>.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of said meeting be published in the Fernandina Beach News-Leader, a newspaper of general circulation in Nassau County, Florida, at least two weeks prior to the date of said hearing, said notice to be in substantially the form as indicated on the attached.
