RESOLUTION 87-59

OFFICIAL RECORDS.

A RESOLUTION CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING OF THOSE CERTAIN RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR THE RENOUNCING AND DISCLAIMING OF ANY RIGHT OR INTEREST OF SAID NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND THE PUBLIC IN SAID RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR ALLEYS.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at $\underline{9.3} \circ$ o'clock $\frac{1}{2}$ m., on the $\underline{8}^{\prime\prime}$ day of $\underline{5t_{0}0t_{0}bt_{0}}$, 1987, at the Nassau County Courthouse Annex Building, Nassau County, Florida, pursuant to a notice duly published as provided by law upon the Petition of James S. Stevens requesting this Board to close, vacate and abandon the roadways or alleyways hereinafter described and to renounce and disclaim the right of the public and the County in and to said roadways and alleyways described as follows:

WHEREAS, no one appeared at said hearing to oppose said Petition, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that said roadways and alleyways lie wholly without the corporate limits of any municipality and that this Board is authorized to close said roadways or alleyways by the authority granted in Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that it is in the best interest of Nassau County and public that said roadways or alleyways be closed, vacated and abandoned and that the interest of Nassau County and the public be renounced and disclaimed therein.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in meeting duly assembled that said roadways or alleyways as hereinbefore described in the preamble hereto be, and the same is, hereby closed, vacated and abandoned to the same extent as if said roadways or alleyways had never been delineated on said plat. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right and interest of Masses (County and the public in said roadways or alleyways above descried be, and the safeter are hereby renounced and disclaimed, and any easement heretofore owned, held, claimed or used by or on behalf of the public therein is hereby abrogated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLED that the Clerk of this Board shall cause to be published, within thirty (30) days after the adoption of this Resolution, in one issue of the Fernandina Beach News Leader, a notice of the adoption of this Resolution closing, vacating and abandoning all of those certain roadways or alleyways as hereinbefore described in the preamble hereto, and the renouncing and disclaiming of any right or interest of the County and the public in said roadways or alleyways.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County commissioners of Nassau County, Florida did on the $\frac{2^{\circ}}{2}$ day of $\frac{5 \cdot p}{2 \cdot p} \frac{1987}{1000}$, adopt a Resolution closing, vacating and abandoning those certain roadways or alleyways, described as follows:

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PARCEL "B"

Portion of Railraod Avenue South (60 foot right of way) Tound in Deed Book 4 Page 478, Section 42, Township 2, North, Range 27 East, Nassau County Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a point where the Easterly right of way of Harts Road as now established by the Florida Department of Transportation (a 66 foot right of way) intersects with A1A (SR 200) Southerly right of way as now established; and run thence along said Southerly right of way North 80°34'34" East a distance of 25.08 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

From the POINT OF BEGINNING continue along said right of way North 80°34'34" East a distance of 61.06 feet; run thence South 18°50'55" East a distance of 288.16 feet; run thence South 71°14'35" West a distance of 60.00 feet; run thence North 18°53'31" West a distance of 298.06 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
