WHEREAS, industry in Nassau County is vital to the County's economic health; and

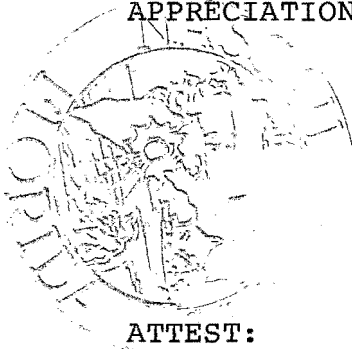
WHEREAS, Nassau County's existing industries are the key to a prosperous future; and
