After some discussion, the County Attorney provided to the Board a description of roads to be closed by the county that would only affect those residents in the area who desired to have their roads closed. A description of the roads are as follows:

Florida Avenue from the edge of Lot 1289 to edge of the powerline road - on map provided this affects Lots 1289, 1288, 1298, and 1299.

Fifth Avenue from the intersection of Lot 1284 and 1280 all the way to Ohio Avenue. This affects Lots 1267, 1272, 1280, 1284, 1271, and 1268.

Fifth Street - from the intersection from Ohio Avenue to northern boundary down to Meadows Lane, southern boundary from Meadows Lane to Ohio Avenue from Florida Avenue as previously stated.

Commissioner Testone made motion adopting Resolution No. 87-63 - A Resolution Closing and Abandoning those Certain Roads as above described, subject to Champion International granting easements for said property, subject to Champion International drafting a letter of intent to grant easements so that utility permits can be issued and subject to the County Attorney obtaining legal descriptions for the above described property. Motion seconded by Commissioner Pickett and voted unanimously.
