

RESOLUTION NO.: 88 -2

WHEREAS, the municipalities of Florida, by specific statutory authority, may enact franchise fee ordinances; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners believes that counties should have similar statutory authority; and


WHEREAS, to statutorily prevent counties from executing the same authority penalizes the citizens of the unincorporated areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of October, 1987, that the Board of County Commissioners respectfully requests that:

1.) Senator Girardeau and Representative Crady work to eliminate this statutory difference by providing for counties to enact said fees.

2.) Senator Girardeau and Representative Crady introduce a special act granting Nassau County the statutory authority for said fee.
