## RESOLUTION 88 - 50

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 88-30, WHICH APPROVED THE APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL FOR THE YULEE WOODS/LOFTON BLUFF/WILSON NECK DEVELOPMENT FOR A DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, on the 19th day of January, 1988, previously approved Resolution 88-30; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs has filed an Intention to Appeal said Resolution based upon the requirement for additional acreage for the gopher preserve; and

WHEREAS, the developer and the State have reached an agreement to increase the preserve acreage; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered this Resolution at a duly held public meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this  $26^{\prime\prime}$  day of April, 1988, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 88-30 be amended as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 11 shall be amended as follows:
- 11. A conservation easement shall be incorporated into the drainage easement in Parcel A to guarantee the preservation of the wetland system within this easement. A portion of Tract B shall be preserved in perpetuity to provide a habitat for the gopher tortoise, gopher frog, Florida Pine Snake, and other

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wildlife species which utilize this habitat. The exact boundary is identified in Exhibit-"C"-attached the exhibit attached to the letter of April 18, 1988, from William F. Sheffield to Colonel Brantly. Said letter and attached drawing shall be attached as Exhibit "C".

- 2. Paragraph 14 is hereby deleted.
- 3. Paragraph 15 is hereby deleted.
- 4. All other provisions of Resolution 88-30 remain in full force and effect.

The Clerk shall transmit a Certified Copy of this Resolution by Certified Mail to the Department of Community Affairs, the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council, and the applicant/developer.

Dear Colonel Brantly:

As one-third owner and managing partner of the aforesaid development in Nassau County, Florida, I do hereby promise and agree to do the following:

We agree to grant a permanent conservation easement on 42 acres as outlined in the attached legal description and map. This is the property as sketched in and outlined on our engineering plans in your office at our meeting April 11, 1988. We also agree to find an organization or trust acceptable to your agency to deed the property to as soon as possible. We also agree to deliver a stamped warranty deed to any organization, trust, or entity your agency recommends to us. We also agree to furnish a staked survey and place permanent concrete markers on the corner boundary lines of the 42 acres. We agree to fence the entire 42 acres with three strands of barbed wire on 2 to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch line posts and place posted signs around the 42 acre conservation area. This work will be done when survey crews stake out adjoining subdivision lots and roads are being built.

The Nassau County Commission agreed to remove the ten acre park from the conservation area last month and a letter from the County Attorney to that vote was mailed to the Department of Community Affairs. We agree to delete the road through the middle of the conservation area so the 42 acres will not include any road.

Colonel Brantly, we appreciate your help and cooperation.


