RESOLUTION NO. 89-4

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statutes, the Clerk of the Circuit Court in the next budget year has the option to be a Fee Officer for that portion of his budget that represents the Circuit Court and Recording Departments of his budget.

WHEREAS, T. J. Greeson, Clerk of the Circuit Court, and the Board of County Commissioners have agreed that it is in the best interest of both the Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Board of County Commissioners for the Clerk to operate the above portion of his budget from fees and previously approved fine "Clerk of Court-Court Fund" as established by Resolution No. 88-57.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in lawful session duly assembled that:

- 1. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Nassau County, Florida shall operate off of a fee system and authorized fines, "Clerk of Court-Court Fund", for his Circuit Court and Recording Department as authorized by Florida Statutes.
- The "Clerk of Court-Court Fund" set up by Resolution No. 88-57 shall be part of the Clerk of Circuit Courts Fee System in support of the Circuit Court and Recording Divisions. Said funds shall be accounted for as other revenues from the fee system. Any excess fees shall be retained by the Clerk for future budget purposes for capital outlay items.

This action shall be effective as of October 1, 1988.
