A RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING NASSAU COUNTY'S INTENTION TO CONTINUE THE FIFTY CENT (50) FEE PER TELEPHONE LINE IN NASSAU COUNTY FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A "911" SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 87-53 on the 27th day of September, 1987; and


WHEREAS, the Ordinance provided for a recurring "911" fee on an annual basis; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14th day of July, 1989, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. The "911" fee as set forth in Ordinance 87-53 shall be continued and shall be continued on an annual basis thereafter unless terminated by the Board.
