

The Nassau County Board of County Commissioners met in Regular Session this 25th day of April, 1989 at 1:00 P.M. Present were: James E. Testone, Chairman; Commissioners James B. Higginbotham, Hazel Jones, Thomas D. Branan and Jimmy L. Higginbotham. Also present were: Michael S. Mullin, County Attorney; T. J. "Jerry" Greeson, Ex-Officio Clerk; Joanna R. Cason, Chief Operations Officer; and Joyce Bradley, Deputy Clerk.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and the Clerk led in prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Commissioner Branan made motion approving the following minutes:

April 11, 1989 April 17, 1989

Regular Session Regular Session

Motion seconded by Commissioner Higginbotham, District 5, and voted unanimously.

Mr. Ron Featherston, 911 Consultant, appeared before the Board at this time. The Clerk informed the Board that Mr. Featherston is using his mobile telephone to enhance or conduct his private business. Mr. Featherston stated that there were certain verbal agreements may with Chief Graves that did not translate into his contact, and stated that he would pay the costs of all personal calls placed on this mobile telephone.

Mr. Featherston informed the Board that his contract will expire soon and stated that he would like to renew his contract with the county. The Board instructed Mr. Featherston and the County Attorney to draft a renewal contract for the Board's consideration and approval.

Captain Rocky Mistler, Administrative Aide to the Sheriff, appeared before the Board and informed them that the Callahan Police Department has disbanded and stated that he would like to request a budget amendment in the amount of \$17,356.25. Captain Mistler informed the Board that these monies would be used to place one deputy in Callahan for the period covering May 1,1989 through September 30, 1989. The Board instructed the Clerk to prepare said budget amendment and bring same back to the Board at their next meeting.

The County Attorney informed the Board that the Town of Hilliard is trying to do a bond issue for roads and stated that they had been working on the bond until the insurance company said they would not insure it. The County Attorney stated that the Town of Hilliard is seeking to enter into an interlocal

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
