

## RESOLUTION NO. 89- 90

WHEREAS on September 7, 1989, the Nassau County Board of County Commission held a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes for the fiscal year from October 1, 1989 to September 30, 1990, and


WHEREAS, on September 25th, 1989 the Nassau County Board of County Commission held a public hearing to finalize the 1989-90 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commission of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 25th day of September, 1989, adopted the following millage rates individually adopted for the fiscal year from October 1, 1989, to September 30, 1990:


