WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, had been advised that the County was in jeopardy of losing Kings Bay Impact funds; and


WHEREAS, these funds are necessary to address the impact from the Kings Bay submarine base; and

WHEREAS, it was necessary to travel to Washington, D.C., to meet with various members of Congress and their staffs; and

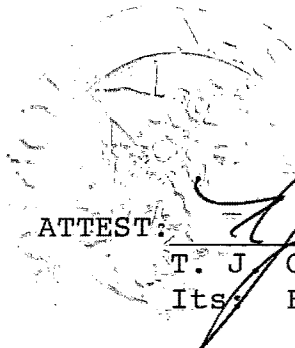
WHEREAS, the Committee of 100 sent its Chairman, Bill Bertke, at the Committee's expense, to Washington in order to assist the County's representatives.
