1. Pursuant to Ordinance 87-18, Section IV, Paragraph D(1), the above stated changes shall be made.


2. As agreed upon, street signs shall be erected by the Pirate's Wood home owners association to show the names of the roads as shown on the map attached hereto and made a part hereof.
