WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services requested the assistance of the U.S. Navy's Demolition Squad with EOD Kings Bay; and


WHEREAS, the Navy's team cooperated with the Department of Emergency Services and gave of their time in order to assist in the protection of the citizens of Nassau County.

to the citizens of Nassau County, Florida:


