

RESOLUTION 90 - 117

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THAT A PROPOSITION CALLING FOR SINGLE MEMBER REPRESENTATION WITHIN THE COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 124.011, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners may submit, to the electors of the County, a proposition calling for single member districts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the electorate that either the Commission be elected by be single member districts only or that they be elected by district with two (2) at-large members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 9th day of July, 1990 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Supervisor of Elections is hereby directed to place on the ballot, for the general election to be held this year, as follows:

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, be increased from five (5) to seven (7) members with five (5) of the seven (7) members to be elected to office from single member districts by electors residing in each of those districts only and with the two (2) remaining members being elected by all electors at-large?

2. No County Commissioner elected prior to or at the general election which approves any revisions shall be affected in his years' office.

3. The representation by district shall become effective as of the next general election in 1992.
