

RESOLUTION 90-128

WHEREAS the 911 Operations and Maintenance Fund has received a transfer from the General Fund to cover anticipated shortages in the fund. Transfer was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on July 13, 1990.

WHEREAS these revenues were not anticipated in the 1989/90 budget for the 911 Operations and Maintenance Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 24th day of July, 1990, the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06(2)(d) be adopted:
