

RESOLUTION 90-137

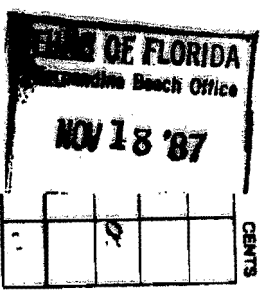

Dear Mike:

In keeping with the assurance mentioned in the first paragraph of your November 9th letter with reference to the limited use of the funds, I enclose herewith check of North End Co., Inc. in the sum of \$25,000.00. Hopefully, the County will not unduly delay the paving of Johnson Lake Road and not wait as long as three years. I would appreciate your taking care of the agreement mentioned in the last sentence of your first paragraph of that letter and forwarding that instrument to me.

In the second paragraph, you stated '* * upon receipt of the money and approval of the plat * * *'. It is my understanding that the approval of the plat is absolutely fait accompli. In other words, one of the very important, perhaps main, conditions of my client's depositing \$25,000 is absolute approval of the plat, which I presume by now has been done. If not, will you please step on some toes and let me know that the plat has been approved. Thereafter, the move-on permits will be requested, as needed.

Certainly, we both appreciate the fact that once the details are followed through and accomplished by you and the County, we can then, at least in one respect, relax.
