RESOLUTION 90 - 60

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE LAW SUIT FILED BY THE SHERIFFS OF FLORIDA AND SHERIFF ELLIS, CHALLENGING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF GAIN TIME AND PROVISIONAL RELEASE CREDITS.

WHEREAS, crime is the number one concern of the citizens of Nassau County and the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, there exists a revolving prison door system whereby prisoners serve less and less of their time; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners supports the Sheriffs in their law suit to correct this major flaw in the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>23rd</u> day of January, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners endorses and approves the Florida Sheriffs' challenge as to gain time and provisional release credits.
- 2. The Board urges the State to commit the resources necessary to address this very serious problem.
