

## RESOLUTION 90 - 81

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 83-25, WHICH SET FORTH REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BEACH PERMIT STICKERS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 83-25; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution contained a provision to exempt vehicle owners that are sixty-five (65) years of age or over; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that vehicle owners who are handicapped or disabled should also be exempt; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has adopted Ordinance 90-10 providing that the beach permits shall be valid for twenty-four (24) hour per day periods on an annual basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of March, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 83-25 shall be amended as follows:

- 1. Section 10 shall be deleted.
- 2. A new Section 10 shall read: There shall be no permit fee required for vehicle owners who are handicapped or disabled, pursuant to Florida Statutes. Those vehicle owners who are handicapped or disabled, pursuant to Florida Statutes, may utilize their existing handicapped/disabled vehicle sticker as

and for a beach permit sticker.
