

RESOLUTION 91-26

WHEREAS the Grants Account Fund has received cash from the Recreation and Parks Trust Fund to be used for additional work to be done at Burney Park by Tomasini-Hall, Inc. Board approved use of District 1 parks and recreation funds at its September 25, 1990 meeting.

WHEREAS these revenues were not anticipated in the 1990/91 budget for the Grants Account Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 13th day of November, 1990, the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06(2)(d) be adopted:



Motion seconded by Commissioner Higginbotham, District 1, and voted unanimously.

Commissioner Higginbotham, District 1, stated that the Beach Committee has recommended the extension of the contract with Goodwin Beach Cleaning through November and stated Mr. Goodwin is to bring back information for the contract amount for the beach cleaning services during the winter months. The County Engineer stated that he had no objection to this. Commissioner Higginbotham, District 1, made motion authorizing the extension of the county's contract with Beach Cleaners, Inc. for beach cleaning for the months of October and November at the current rate of \$4,590.00 per month. Motion seconded by Commissioner Branan and voted unanimously.

The County Engineer presented to the Board a request for the extension of the contract with Ionasini-Hall, Inc. for additional work which would include the installation of picnic shelters and tables at Burney Park. The County Engineer stated that this is not a budgeted item but stated that he has spoken with the County Attorney regarding the use of park/recreation funds from the commission district for this additional work. The County Attorney stated that the County Engineer would have to look at the number of

permits in the nearby subdivisions to make a determination that these impact the park and the Board would have to clarify that these are impact related and only impact related. The County Engineer stated that the area impacted would be Will Love Hardee Road, Citrona Boulevard, Simmons Road and the Plantation Point Subdivision area. Commissioner Higginbotham, District 1, whose district this would be in, stated that in looking at the impacts collected this would justify the expenditure of these funds for the shelters and tables. Commissioner Higginbotham, District 1, made motion authorizing the use of District 1 Park and Recreation Funds in the amount of \$15,250 for picnic shelters and picnic tables to be an addition to the contract with Tonassini-Hall and that this is directly caused by the impact of the subdivisions in the area which have impacted the area. Motion seconded by Commissioner Jones and voted unanimously.
