WHEREAS, Harry Poole did a great deal towards the improvement of the lives of the citizens of Nassau County; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of November, 1990, that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereby:


1. Acknowledges the tremendous services that Harry Poole rendered as a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County.

family on behalf of all the citizens of Nassau County.


