

RESOLUTION 91 - 50

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE STATE OF FLORIDA PURCHASE LAND ON AMERICAN BEACH TO PRESERVE SAND DUNES AND COASTAL HAMMOCK.

WHEREAS, there are sand dunes located in American Beach that are the tallest and most pristine in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, there is coastal hammock that should be preserved; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received a request to encourage the preservation of the sand dunes and oak hammock area on a parcel of property on American Beach; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has a program to purchase real property for preservation purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 24th day of January, 1991, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:

1. The State of Florida is hereby requested to include real property located on American Beach in Nassau County, Florida on its CARL list for future purchase and preservation.

2. The real property is bound by Lewis Street on the North; Ocean Street on the East; Burney Road on the South; and A1A on the West.


