BOND ROAD PAVING BUDGET AFTER 2ND YEAR ARBITRAGE

CALCULATION

Coopers and Lybrand, CPA, just completed their interest earnings arbitrage calculation for the year end 3/1/91 (2nd bond year). Based upon their interest rebate calculation, as of 3/1/91 the available balance for road paving in the 302 fund totaled \$8,676,718.63. Due to expenditures from 3/2/91 through 5/21/91, \$8,499,460.42 is available as of 5/21/91. Based upon our analysis a budget amendment for \$269,010.50 will be processed for the 6/10/91 Board meeting, bringing the amended budget for fund 302 "Capital Projects-Road Paving" to \$8,731,305.50. We are still looking into the three year spending limitation for bond proceeds and will communicate any information we receive. Thank you.
