RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Nassau County Anti-Drug Enforcement Grant Fund has and is to receive Federal pass-through grant funds from the State of Florida, representing a 75% of expenditures. Nassau County has received matching from drug fines and contributions to finance the County's 25% match. Revenue and expenditures relate to DARE YEAR 1 grant.

WHEREAS these revenues were not anticipated in the 1992/93 budget for the Nassau County Anti-Drug Enforcement Grant Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 25th day of October, 1993, the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06(2)(d) be adopted:


