

RESOLUTION 94 - 147

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A  
USS SARATOGA MUSEUM IN JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, The United States Navy plans to decommission the USS Saratoga during the calendar year 1994, and to make it available for operation as a naval museum; and

WHEREAS, the First Coast Area has been a center for naval operations for nearly half a century; and


WHEREAS, a museum located on the St. Johns River would afford the opportunity for citizens of the First Coast area, as well as foreign visitors, to learn of the vital role played by naval operations in the nation's defense.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of June, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. Nassau County endorses the concept of the USS Saratoga Museum on the St. Johns River in Duval County, Florida.
