## RESOLUTION 94 - 170

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 87-21, WHICH ESTABLISHED A FEE FROM EACH TRAFFIC FINE COLLECTED BY THE COUNTY COURT WHICH IS DESIGNATED FOR THE COUNTY SHALL BE TENDERED TO THE SHERIFF FOR THE SCHOOL CROSSING PURPOSE; INCREASING THE FEE FROM \$4.00 TO \$10.00; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 87-21; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to increase said fee from \$4.00 to \$10.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 22nd day of August, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 87-21 be amended as follows:

- 1. Prior to the division of traffic fine monies for the County and the City, four (\$4.00) dollars ten dollars (\$10.00) from each traffic fine collected shall be tendered to the Sheriff's department for the School Crossing Program.
- 2. The monies to be disbursed by the Clerk pursuant to procedures set forth by his office.
- 3. This Resolution shall become effective on September 1, 1994.
