- 1. Prior to the division of traffic fine monies for the County and the City, four (\$4.00) dollars ten dollars (\$10.00) from each traffic fine collected shall be tendered to the Sheriff's department for the School Crossing Program. The six dollar (\$6.00) increase is to be taken from the 56.4% of the County's fines.
- 2. The monies to be disbursed by the Clerk pursuant to procedures set forth by his office.
 - 3. This Resolution shall become effective on September 1,
