
WHEREAS, on September 26th, 1994 the Nassau County Board of County Commission held a public hearing to finalize the 1994-95 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commission of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 26th day of September, 1994, adopted the following millage rates individually adopted for the fiscal year from October 1, 1994, to September 30, 1995:

FINE AND FORFEITURE FUND	2.6964
COUNTY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND	0.9200
PUBLIC HEALTH	<u>0.2186</u>
TOTAL GENERAL MILLAGE (COUNTY WIDE)	6.8321
MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT(dependent)	.3224
REC & WATER CONSERVATION DIST 1(dependent)	.0508


The total millage rates for the County including the dependent districts represents an 11.98 percent increase in property taxes over the rolled-back rate.
