RESOLUTION NO. 94-47

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 90-1, WHICH ADOPTED A DOLLAR AMOUNT PER TON FOR THE DISPOSAL OF CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS AT COUNTY-OWNED LANDFILLS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 90-1 provides for the imposition of a dollar amount per ton for the disposal of construction and demolition debris at County-owned landfills; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been made aware that the disposal fee for construction and demolition debris should be increased from \$25.00 per ton to \$45.00 per ton; and

WHEREAS, the Board feels it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County, Florida, that the disposal fee be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>24th</u> day of <u>January</u>, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 90-1 be amended as follows:

1. Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Ordinance 90-1, the tipping fee <u>for disposal of construction and demolition debris at County-</u> <u>owned landfills</u> is hereby established to be Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) <u>Forty-five dollars \$45.00</u>, per ton.

2. This Resolution shall become effective on the <u>lst</u> day of <u>February</u>, 1994.
