## RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NASSAU COUNTY HOUSING INCENTIVE PLAN FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENHANCING THE DEVELOPMENT OF VERY LOW AND LOW INCOME HOUSING WITHIN THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Section 420.9072(9), Florida Statutes and Rule 91-37, F.A.C., as amended, requires that the County adopt an Affordable Housing Incentive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Incentive Plan must be adopted by the Board of County Commissioners within one year of the County's adoption of the ordinance implementing the SHIP Program within Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of Commissioners believes that the Incentive Plan presented to the Commission and recommended by the County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee will satisfy the requirements of Rule 91-37, F.A.C., and will enhance the delivery of affordable housing within the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Nassau County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the Affordable Housing Incentive Plan as presented on this 1422 day of March, 1994.
