**A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE FOLLOWING  
STREET NAME IN THE HILLIARD AREA**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, believe that the following changes are beneficial to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Nassau County: and

**WHEREAS**, the following changes will help establish a consistent street naming and addressing grid for all emergency systems as is intended by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners as stated in Ordinance 87-18 and Ordinance 88-23; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Sections 16, 20, 21 and 47 of Township 2N, Range 25E, have petitioned the 9-1-1 Operations Office for change of street name; and


**WHEREAS**, the 9-1-1 Coordinator's Office has reviewed the requests in accordance with Ordinance Number 92-14; and

**WHEREAS**, the Nassau County Department of Public Safety has recommended that the unnamed road which extends west off C R 121 just north of Rowe Cutoff; located in Section 22; Township 2N; Range 23E; be named "MANNING LAKE DRIVE"; due to a conflict in the 9-1-1 addressing grid; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the above street names shall be changed and street signs shall be erected by the Road and Bridge Department to reflect these changes, and new designations.


