WHEREAS, the majority of Citizens of Nassau County currently residing on *Unnamed Easement in Sect. 8, TW 2N, Rge 27E* have requested that the street be renamed *William Burgess Boulevard*, and

WHEREAS, the residents understand that they must pay for the construction and placement of new street signs reflecting this change, and

WHEREAS, the 911 Coordinator's office has reviewed the request in accord with Ordinance Number 92-14, and has verified the request as acceptable and not in conflict with names already assigned, and


WHEREAS, the 911 Coordinator's office has forwarded the request to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration, now

Dear Ms. Cox:

It is the intention of the Florida Community College at Jacksonville to build an access road from A1-A to a proposed Nassau County Campus in Yulee, Florida. This road as shown on the attached maps will be hard surfaced, approximately 8,600 feet in length, and will be constructed between now and May 1, 1995.

On behalf of the College and the donors of the property on which this road will be constructed, I am requesting that the road be officially named William Burgess Road. As an alternative, should the proposed name be unacceptable, I would submit the name, Nassau Center Road.

It should be noted that the master plan for the development of the area shows the extension of the road from the campus to US 17 just north of the Stone Container Corporation. The proposed name should apply to this extension when construction is complete.










LOCATION MAP
