

RESOLUTION 96- 04

WHEREAS, §125.014, Florida Statutes, provides for tourist development tax revenues; and


WHEREAS, there appears to be doubt and confusion as to whether tourist development funds can be utilized for lifeguards; and

WHEREAS, utilization of lifeguards promotes and enhances the use of the beaches in Nassau County, one of the county's premier tourist attractions.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 8th day of January, 1996 as follows:

1. The Board requests that the Legislative Delegation seek to amend §125.014, Florida Statutes, to include the expenditure of money for lifeguards within the definition of tourist related projects.
2. Copies of this Resolution be presented to the Legislative Delegation at their local meeting on January 17, 1996.


