

RESOLUTION NO. 96-126

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, SEEKING A SEPARATE HEAD START PROGRAM FOR NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Children and Families, Office of Family Support Services is soliciting expression of interest from Florida public or private non-profit entities which are interested in operating Head Start programs; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County has been arbitrarily placed with Baker, Bradford, and Union Counties; and

WHEREAS, there are no public or private entities serving these counties; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, believes that the children and parents in the Head Start programs can best be served by educational and social agencies in Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 24th day of June, 1996, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


Requesting that a separate/individual program for Nassau County be considered.


