WHEREAS, Celeste Kavanaugh's and Marie Louise Chaplin's determination and devotion to this project serve as shining examples for all citizens; and


WHEREAS, Celeste Kavanaugh and Marie Louise Chaplin serve as examples of all that is good about our county.


2. Hopes that, like the light we activate tonight, Celeste Kavanaugh and Marie Louise Chaplin will continue to be guiding lights for Nassau County.


