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RESOLUTION NO. 96-186 OFFICIAL RECORDS

RESOLUTION CLOSING, VACATING, AND ABANDONING OF A PORTION OF A CERTAIN ROADWAY KNOWN AS BURNEY ROAD AS SET FORTH ON PLAT RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 2, PAGE 64 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at 8:00 p.m. o'clock, on the 23rd day of September, 1996, at the Yulee County Building, in Yulee, Florida, pursuant to a NOTICE duly published as provided by law upon the petition of the Amelia Island Company, requesting this Board to vacate, renounce and disclaim any right of the County and the Public in and to a portion of a certain roadway, known as Burney Road, delineated on that certain plat recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 64, of the Public Records of Nassau County, Florida, being described as follows:

Part of Section 20, Township 2 North Range 28 East, Nassau County, Florida, Also being a part of Tract A, American Beach Section Three, As Recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 64 of the Public Records of Said County, more particularly described as follows: For a Point of Beginning, commence at the Intersection of the Northerly right-of-Way of Burney Road (an 80 foot right-of-way as now established) with the Easterly right-of-way line of State Road A1A (a 200 foot right-of-way as now established); Thence North 85°01'42" East leaving said Easterly right-of-way line of State Road A1A and along the Northerly right-of-way line of Burney Road, a distance of 1823.86 feet to a point on a curve, said curve being concave Northwesterly having a radius of 50.00 feet; Thence Southwesterly leaving said Northerly right-of-way line of Burney Road and along the arc of said curve, an arc distance of 22.88 feet, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing of South 61°23'15" West and a chord distance of 22.68 feet to the point of reverse curve, said curve being concave Southeasterly having a radius of 540.00 feet; Thence Southwesterly along the arc of said curve, an arc distance of 50.07 feet, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing of South $71^{\circ}32'53''$ west and a chord distance of 55.57 feet to the Point of Tangency of said curve; Thence South $68^{\circ}35'55''$ West along a line to its intersection with the Southerly right-of-way line of Burney Road, a distance of 204.89 feet; Thence South 85°01'42" West along said Southerly right-of-way line of Burney Road to its intersection with the aforementioned Easterly right-of-way line of State Road

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A1A, a distance of 1554.88 feet to a point on a Girde, Faid Curve being concave Easterly having a radius of 5629.58 feet; Thence Northerly along said Easterly right-of-way line of State Road A1A and along the arc of said curve, an arc distance of 80.02 feet, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing of North 03°16'58" West and a chord distance of 80.02 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Containing 3.10 acres more or less.

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that Amelia Island Company owns the portions of real property in Nassau County, Florida, which border the aforesaid road, and

WHEREAS, Amelia Island Company has agreed to donate property in order to re-align the existing Burney Road, and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the new alignment is beneficial to the citizens of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that the public will not be harmed by the vacating of the above road, and

WHEREAS, the Amelia Island Company will undertake to fund roadwork on Burney Road, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that said land lies wholly without the corporate limits of any municipality and that this Board is authorized to close said roadways or alleyways by the authority granted in Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the closing, vacating, and abandoning of a portion of Burney Road is conditioned on Amelia Island Company re-aligning and performing roadwork on Burney Road, pursuant to county standards, and

WHEREAS, the closing, vacating, and abandoning will occur simultaneously with the county approval and acceptance of the re-

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alignment and roadwork.

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that it is in the best interest of Nassau County that said roadway described herein be closed, vacated and abandoned, that no individual would be harmed thereby, and that the interest of Nassau County and the public be renounced and disclaimed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in a meeting duly assembled, that said roadway described in the preamble hereto be, and the same is, hereby closed, vacated and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right and interest of Nassau County and the public in said roadway above described be, and the same will be renounced and disclaimed, and any easement heretofore owned, held, claimed or used by or on behalf of the public herein will be abrogated, subject to the following conditions: 1. The re-alignment and roadwork on Burney Road be completed to county standards; and 2. The Director of Public Works issue a written certification that the re-alignment and roadwork meets county standards and the Board of County Commissioners accepting the realignment and roadwork.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board shall cause to be published within thirty (30) days after formal notification by separate resolution, of the conditions being met, in one issue of the Fernandina Beach News-Leader, a newspaper of general circulation published in Nassau County, Florida, a notice of adoption of this Resolution which Notice shall be in
