

RESOLUTION 96- 199

WHEREAS on September 18, 1996, the Nassau county Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes for the fiscal year from October 1, 1996 to September 30, 1997 and

WHEREAS, on September 30th, 1996 the Nassau County Board of County Commission held a public hearing to finalize the 1996/97 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commission of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 30th day of September, 1996, adopted the following millage rates individually adopted for the fiscal year from October 1, 1996, to September 30, 1997:

TOTAL COUNTY WIDE MILLAGE	6.7321
MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT	.3224
REC & WATER CONSERVATION DIST. 1	.0000

The total millage rates for the County including the dependent districts represents a .50% increase in property taxes over the rolled-back rate.
