

RESOLUTION NO. 96-59

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE COUNTY SEAT BOUNDARIES OF NASSAU COUNTY WHICH WOULD INCLUDE THE AREA ONE MILE NORTH AND SOUTH OF HIGHWAY A1A (STATE ROAD 200), COMMENCING AT THE ATLANTIC OCEAN AND RUNNING DIRECTLY TO INTERSTATE 95

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized, pursuant to Florida Statutes 138.12, to expand the geographic areas of the county seat; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds, after two public hearings, that it is necessary to expand the geographic area of the county seat;

WHEREAS, the expansion of the county seat is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 25th day of March, 1996 that:

1. The geographic area of the county seat of Nassau County is hereby expanded to include the area set forth on the attached drawing.
2. The area depicted on the attached drawing shall henceforth be considered to be within the geographic area of the county seat of Nassau County.


