A RESOLUTION OPPOSING SENATE BILL 1952 AND ANY RELATED HOUSE BILLS RELATING TO INCREASED SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has been made aware that said proposed legislation relates to Sovereign Immunity; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has been made aware that said proposed legislation could increase the county's liability premium by at least thirty (30) percent for the first year by increasing the Sovereign Immunity Limit from \$100,000 per person and \$200,000 per occurrence to a new limit of \$250,000 per person and \$500,000 per occurrence.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is opposed to said legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>25th</u> day of <u>March</u>, 1996, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:
