

RESOLUTION NO. 97-123

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE BILL RELATING TO NASSAU COUNTY WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SUM OF \$100,000 OF GENERAL REVENUE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Department of Revenue failed to implement the Ninth Cent Gas Tax collections in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Revenue has admitted that they failed to implement the tax and has taken full responsibility for the error; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County vitally needs the \$100,000 in order to compensate the county for the loss of revenue.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 21st day of April, 1997, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:
