## RESOLUTION NO. 97-136

## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SB 902 AND HB 1319

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 902 creates a Trust Fund as a placeholder to earmark funds that will be used to assist counties in funding the State Courts System; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 1319 provides a revenue source for the trust fund created by Senate Bill 902, by establishing a four-year phase-in of the state's portion of the General Revenue dollars from civil traffic infractions; and

WHEREAS, a committee of fifteen individuals will be established to develop an allocation and disbursement plan for the trust fund; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 1319 includes the Court Improvement Fund legislation which will allow additional fines of up to \$150.00 to be assessed against certain criminals, the funds of which would remain local for court improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>12th</u> day of May, 1997, by the Board of County Commissioners, of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

 That the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida hereby supports SB 902 and HB 1319.
