RESOLUTION NO. 97-230

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE BE INSTALLED AND THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT BE REDUCED FROM OTIS ROAD TO THE BRYCEVILLE FIRE STATION

WHEREAS, the existing speed limit is posted at 55 miles per hour on the segment of Highway 301 from Otis Road to the Bryceville Fire Station in Bryceville, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this section of highway is heavily congested; and

WHEREAS, a traffic control device and a reduced speed zone would assist the flow of traffic in a more orderly manner; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, believes it is in the best interest of the public's safety that the posted speed limit on the segment of Highway 301 from Otis Road to the Bryceville Fire Station should not exceed 45 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this <u>24th</u> day of November, 1997, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, requests that the Florida Department of Transportation install the appropriate traffic control device and reduce the posted speed limit to 45 miles per hour on Highway 301 from Otis Road to the Bryceville Fire Station.
