RESOLUTION NO. 98-03

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING LANGUAGE FOR SIGNAGE FOR COUNTY OWNED FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it necessary to place particular informational/warning signs at various properties owned or controlled by the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to provide said signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 12th day of January, 1998, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:

1. Beach Front Parks

All county owned or operated beach front parks shall have signs posted indicating the following information:

- No lifeguards on duty swim at your own risk
- No regular security patrols
- Please watch your children closely
- No alcoholic beverage consumption pursuant to Ordinance No. 93-15
- The use of glass containers on the Atlantic Ocean beaches is prohibited
- Horses, ponies, burros or any other animal of an equine nature shall not be unloaded within Peters Point Park except within the designated parking areas
- Parking for trailers and other conveyances shall be designated within Peters Point Park. Said trailer shall clearly display the proper permit pursuant to Resolution No. 96-185
- All dogs shall be kept on a leash

2. Athletic Facilities

All county owned, controlled or operated athletic complexes shall have signs posted indicating the following information:

- No regular security patrols
- Please watch your children closely
- No alcoholic beverage consumption pursuant to Ordinance No. 93-15
- All animals shall be kept on a leash

3. Boat Ramps

All county owned or controlled boat ramps shall have signs posted indicating the following information:

- No regular security patrols
- No alcoholic beverage consumption pursuant to Ordinance No. 93-15
- All animals shall be kept on a leash
