## **RESOLUTION 98-123**

WHEREAS the Capital Projects-Taxing Funds Fund is no longer considered necessary and capital outlay expenditures by department are to be accounted for with other department operational costs.

WHEREAS the Fund was established in 1994/95 with revenue provided by transfers from the General, Fine and Forfeiture, County Transportation and Municipal Service Funds. Subsequent money has been received for the South End Park.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1998 that the Capital Projects-Taxing Funds Fund be abolished and balances transferred to the General, County Transportation, Municipal Service and Capital Projects-Grant Funds based upon current Capital Projects-Taxing Funds Fund designations.
