the County Coordinator, the Clerk, and himself and to bring back a recommendation to the Board. They would also talk with Mr. Tyson, Mr. Hardin, and representatives from other counties. Commissioner Crawford requested a more formal response to the questions raised by Mr. Tyson. It was moved by Commissioner Deonas, seconded by Commissioner Marshall, and unanimously carried to form a committee comprised of Commissioner Crawford, the County Coordinator, the Clerk, and the County Attorney to research the County's insurance coverage and report back to the Board with an informed recommendation.

Commissioner Kirkland read and presented citations to Sherrill Roberts, Captain Tom Loveless, Engineer Roger Reeves, and Greg Blankenship for saving the lives of four teenagers on February 17, 1998.

The Board considered a request from the American Beach Property Owners' Association, Inc. for approval of a plan for the continuation of the American Beach Streetscape. Ms. Annette Myers, President of the Association, appeared before the Board and referred to the funds in the amount of \$18,000 that were given to the County by the Amelia Island Plantation for use in the American Beach community. She stated that in March 1997 the Association presented to the Board a proposal for the use of those funds for
